Proclaiming District under the Inspection of Machinery Act, 1908.

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS it is enacted by section three of the Inspection of Machinery Act, 1908 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), that the Governor-General may by Proclamation from time to time divide New Zealand into districts, with such boundaries as he thinks convenient, and may assign to any such district a name by which it shall be known for the purposes of the said Act; and may in like manner from time to time alter the boundaries of districts:

And whereas it is desirable to proclaim a district under the said Act to be called the North Auckland District:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section three of the said Act, do hereby proclaim and declare that the area described in the Schedule hereto shall be a district for the purposes of the said Act, and that it shall be known by the name of the North Auckland District.
