Plants declared to be Noxious Weeds by the Tamahere Road Board.—Notice No. 1947.

IT is hereby notified for public information that the Tamahere Road Board has, by special order, declared the following weeds to be noxious weeds within the meaning of the Noxious Weeds Act, 1908, in the district under its jurisdiction:—

African boxthorn (*Lycium horridum*).
Bathurst burr (*Xanthium spinosum*).
Broom (*Cytisus scoparius*).
Burdock (*Achillea*, any species).
Capeweed, or Cape daisy (*Cryptostemma calendulacea*).
Dock (*Rumex*, any species).
Elderberry (*Sambucus niger*).
Fennel (*Feniculum vulgare*).
Foxglove (*Digitalis purpurea*).
Giant burdock (*Arctium majus*).

Goat's rue (*Galega officinalis*).

Kangaroo acacia (*Acacia armata*).
