'RESOLUTION STRIKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN exercise and pursuance of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Wairoa County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest and sinking fund and other charges on a loan of twelve hundred pounds (£1,200), authorized to be raised by the said Council, under the Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1909, for the purpose of paying the Council's proportion of capital expenditure of the Wairoa Hospital and Charitable Aid Board, the said Wairoa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one one-hundredth of a penny in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Wairoa; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the first day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and one-half (36½) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
