Regulations and Amendments to Regulations under the Education Act, 1914.

> LIVERPOOL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this seventeenth day of December, 1918.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE COVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

N pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by section thirty-seven of the Appropriation Act, 1918, and by the Education Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act"), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the regulations in Part I hereunder relating to-

(i.) Grading of schools;

(ii.) Salaries of teachers;

(iii.) Staffing of schools;

(iv.) Limitation of positions to be filled by male and female teachers;

(v.) Transfer of teachers when the grade of a school is increased; (vi.) Transfer of teachers when the grade of a school is reduced;

(vii.) House allowances;

(viii.) Pupil-teachers and probationers:

and doth hereby revoke all regulations hitherto in force in regard to any of the above matters: And doth further make the amendments in Part II hereunder to the regulations relating to-

(i.) Native schools;

(ii.) Attendance registers and returns; and (iii.) Training colleges;

and with the like advice and consent doth prescribe that this Order shall come into force on the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen.

REGULATIONS.—PART I.

I. GRADING OF SCHOOLS.

1. PUBLIC schools shall be classified in the grades and subgrades specified in the schedules in clause 14 hereof.
