THEREAS by section forty-seven of the Customs Act, VV 1913, as extended by section twenty-four of the Regulation of Trade and Commerce Act, 1914, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time, by Order in Council gazetted, prohibit the exportation of any goods the prohibition of the exportation of which is in his opinion necessary in the public interest:

And whereas, in the opinion of the Governor-General, it is necessary in the public interest that the exportation of Russian rouble notes should be prohibited to the extent and
