A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto forms portion of a reserve heretofore vested in the Corporation of the City of Auckland, in trust, for public-cemetery purposes:

And whereas it is expedient that the said land should be proclaimed as a road, and the Auckland City Council has by resolution duly consented to such Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section eleven of the Land Act, 1908, do hereby, with the consent as aforesaid of the Auckland City Council, and with the consent of the Waitemata County Council, being the local authority in whose district the said land is situated, proclaim as a road the land described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land proclaimed as a road: 5 acres 3 roods 22 perches.

Portion of Section 248A, Waikomiti Parish, Block II, Titirangi Survey District.

In the Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L. and S. 2/34c, deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, at Wellington, and thereon coloured red.
