Closing a Road passing through Section 3, Block XVII, Jacob's River Hundred, Southland Land District.

LIVERPOOL, Governor-General. A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the eighteenth day W of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and published in the Gazette of the twenty-sixth day of that month, a portion of Section 3, Block XVII, Jacob's River Hundred, was proclaimed as a road, in pursuance of section eleven of the Land Act, 1908:

And whereas it is desirable that the road described in the Schedule hareter which is not required, should be closed in

order that the same may be granted in exchange for the road proclaimed as hereinbefore mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section eleven of the Land Act, 1908, do hereby, with the consent of the Wallace County Council, being the local authority in whose district the road is situated, pro-claim as closed the road described in the Schedule hereto.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of road closed: 8 acres 3 roods 19 perches.
