A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the Stratford Main Trunk Railway (Tahora deviation), commencing at Tahora, and running in an easterly direction to the Heao Valley, and thence by that valley in a northerly direction to the authorized line near Tatu (hereinafter termed "the said railway"), is a railway the construction of which is authorized by the Railways Authorization Act, 1914:

And whereas it has been determined to construct and maintain a portion of the said railway:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and in exercise of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the middle-line of the said portion of the said railway shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto.
