In pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section four of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the settlement lands described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same are hereby set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or lease to discharged soldiers, under special tenures, in the manner provided in the said Act.

N pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred by section eleven of the Land Act, 1908, I, Arthur William Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby, with the consent of the Whakatane County Council, being the local authority in whose district the lands described in the Schedule hereto are situated, proclaim as roads the lands described in the said Schedule.
