THE Maori Land Board for the Tairāwhiti Maori Land District hereby notifies that a meeting of the owners of the Nuhaka 2b 2r 2 Block is summoned and will be held, in pursuance of Part XVIII of the Native Land Act, 1909, at Nuhaka on Friday, the 14th day of June, 1918, at 10 o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of considering the following proposed resolutions:—

"(1.) That the Order in Council making the said land subject to Part XVI of the Native Land Act, 1909, be revoked under section 296 of the said Act.

"(2.) That a lease of the said land be granted to Ihaka Whanga and Niri Whanga as tenants in common in equal shares for the term of twenty-one years at the yearly rental equal to 5 per cent. of the present Government valuation of the said land for the first ten years of the said term, and at the yearly rental equal to 5 per cent. of the then unimproved Government valuation of the said land for the last eleven years of the said term, with right to compensation for improvements."
