WHEREAS by the three-hundred-and-twenty-first section of the Land Act, 1908, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time, either by general or particular description, and whether the same has been surveyed or not, reserve from sale temporarily, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which in his opinion are required for any of the purposes in the said section mentioned:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby temporarily reserve from sale the lands in the Taranaki, Wellington, and Marlborough Land Districts described in the Schedule hereunder written, for the purposes in the said Schedule specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be temporarily reserved.

SCHEDULE.

TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area in the Taranaki Land District, containing by admeasurement 2 acres 1 rood 13 perches, more or less, being Sections 19 and 20, Block XVI, Ohura Survey District. Bounded towards the north-east by the Wanganui River Road, 676.8 links, to the north-western boundary of Section 21, Block VI aforesaid; thence towards the south-west by the north-western boundary of the said Section 21, 467.4 links, to the Wanganui River Road; thence towards the south-west generally by the last-mentioned road, 208, 179.2, 70.2, 193.7, 166.1, and 190.9 links, to the place of commencement.
