**HOBSON COUNTY COUNCIL.**

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) thereunto enabling, the Hobson County Council hereby resolves as follows:—
