IN exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities vested in him by section eight of the Statute Law Amendment Act, 1917, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby revoke Part I of the regulations made under authority of the said section by Order in Council dated the tenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and seventeen, relating to appointment and payment of teachers and staffing of schools, excepting clause three thereof, and doth hereby amend Part II of the regulations relating to supplementary grants for school committees' incidental expenses during the war with Germany, by substituting for the Schedule to the said Part II the Schedule hereunder; and, with the like advice and consent, doth prescribe that this Order shall come into force on the first publication thereof in the New Zealand Gazette.
