EXTRACT FROM THE JOURNALS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, SATURDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1918.

RESOLVED, "That the report of the Lands Committee, brought up on Friday, the 6th day of December, upon the proposal contained in Paper 174, to reserve permanently Sections 30 and 31, Block XIII, Waipoua Survey District; Allotment 151, Maungatapere Parish; and Allotment 223, Kawakawa Parish, as endowments for primary education, be agreed to."
