IT is hereby notified that a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor-General, under the Land Drainage Act, 1908, praying that the area described in the Schedule hereto may be constituted a drainage district under Part I of the said Act, by name the Drainage District of Whakaronga. All persons affected are hereby called upon to lodge any written objections to or petitions against the constitution of the said drainage district which they desire to lodge, within one month from the first publication of this notice, such objections or petitions to be addressed to the Minister of Internal Affairs, Wellington.

SCHEDULE.

DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES OF PROPOSED DRAINAGE DISTRICT OF WHAKARONGA.

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District, situated in Blocks VIII, XI, and XII, Kairanga Survey District, bounded by a line commencing at the westernmost corner of Original Section 390, Hokowhitu Registration District; thence proceeding in a north-easterly direction along the south-eastern side of the Palmerston-Ashhurst Road to a point opposite the south-western corner of Original Section 5, Hokowhitu Registration District; thence across the road to said corner and along the south-western and north-western boundaries of said Section 5, and along the north-western boundaries of Original Sections 6, 7, 8, and 9, Hokowhitu Registration District, and along the north-eastern boundary of the last named to the Palmerston-Ashhurst Road; thence across that road and north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of that road to a point opposite the south-western corner of Original Section 15, Hokowhitu Registration District; thence across the road to said corner, and along the south-western and north-western boundaries of said Section 15, and along the north-western boundaries of Original Sections 16, 17, and 18, Hokowhitu Registration District, and along the north-eastern boundary of the last named to and across a railway reserve;
