Revoking the Setting-apart of Land for Selection by Discharged Soldiers, under Ordinary Tenures, of Land in the Canterbury Land District.

LIVERPOOL, Governor-General. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section three of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Proclamation made on the fifteenth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, and published in the Gazette of the twenty-first day of September, then instant, setting apart the area of Crown land described in the Schedule hereto for selection by disparged soldiers, under the Land hereto, for selection by discharged soldiers, under the Land Act, 1908.

SCHEDULE.

CANTERBURY LAND DISTRICT.—CHEVIOT COUNTY.

Crown Land.

Section 1, Block VII, Lowry Peaks Survey District: Area, 2,097 acres 1 rood 33 perches.
