

*Returning Officers appointed.***LIVERPOOL, Governor-General.**

WHEREAS by the Legislature Act, 1908, it is, *inter alia*, enacted that the Governor-General may appoint such Returning Officers, Registrars, clerks, and other officers as are required to carry the provisions of the said Act into execution, and that every person so appointed shall hold office during the Governor-General's pleasure:
