IN pursuance of section 60 of the Legislature Amendment Act, 1910, I hereby authorize and require you to proceed according to law to the election of a member of Parliament to serve in the House of Representatives for the Northern Maori Electoral District.

I further direct that you cause the nominations for the said member to be received at the Native Land Court Office, Auckland, not later than noon on the 8th day of December, 1919; and, in the event of the election being contested, that the poll shall be taken on the 16th day of December, 1919.
