Result of Poll on Proposal to raise a Loan.

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, I hereby give notice that a poll of the ratepayers of the Borough of Balclutha was taken on the 12th day of November, 1919, on the proposal of the Balclutha Borough Council to borrow the sum of £3,000 for the purpose of purchasing site, sinking new bore, constructing reservoirs, and making necessary alterations and additions to existing waterworks plant to provide the borough with an improved water-supply.

The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 62, and the number of votes recorded against the proposal was 7; informal, 1.

I therefore declare that the proposal was carried.
