IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section thirty-one of the Reserves and other Lands Disposal and Public Bodies' Empowering Act, 1918, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby amend the Order in Council dated the seventeenth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eight, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the fourteenth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and nine, by deleting the area appearing in the Schedule thereto opposite Herenga L No. 2 Block, and the land-purchase expenses appearing therein opposite Herenga L No. 1 and Herenga L No. 2 Blocks, and substituting therefor "80 acres" and "£93 11s. 4d." respectively.

WHEREAS by section one hundred and thirty-three (a) of the Public Works Act, 1908, it is enacted that a local authority shall not declare any county road or district road to be stopped until the consent thereto of the Governor-General, by Order in Council gazetted, is obtained: And whereas the Waitotara County Council has applied for such consent in respect of the road described in the Schedule hereto:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the above-in-part-recited Act, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby consent to the Waitotara County Council stopping the road described in the Schedule hereto.
