*Notice of Result of Poll on Proposal to raise a Loan.*

IN pursuance of section 12 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, I hereby give notice that a poll of the ratepayers of the Borough of Te Awamutu was taken on the 28th day of February, 1919, upon the proposal of the Te Awamutu Borough Council to borrow the sum of £5,000 by way of special loan for the purpose of forming and grading streets within the Borough of Te Awamutu, and metalling the same for the first time.

The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 56, and the number of votes recorded against the proposal was 11.
