Exportation of Oats.

Customs Department,

IT is hereby notified for public information that the Minister of Customs is prepared to consider applications for the exportation of limited quantities of oats to the United Kingdom and British possessions.

Applications should be addressed to the undersigned at Wellington, and should show the quantity desired to be exported, the name of the exporting vessel, the port of shipment, and the port and probable date of final departure.

Permits will be granted only for shipment by vessels named. If the quantity covered by a permit is not shipped by any vessel named therein, further application will be necessary.
