(Under the Gaming Act, 1908.)

In pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in section 33 of the Gaming Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities it enabling in that behalf, the West-land Racing Club, a racing club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said club"), doth hereby revoke the regulations dated the 29th day of October, 1915, and in lieu thereof doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admission of persons to that part of the Hokitika Racecourse situated in the District of Westland, and known as the Hokitika Racecourse, while the said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club for race
