

Dealing with the four metropolitan areas only, it is found that the inclusion of the suburban portions lowers the death-rate in Auckland and Dunedin.

The total births registered for the four metropolitan areas amounted to 589, as against 620 in February—a decrease of 31. The deaths in March were 280—a decrease of 2 as compared with the previous month. Of the total deaths, males contributed 164, females 116. Forty-seven of the deaths were of children under five years of age, being 16.79 per cent. of the whole number. Thirty-eight of these were under one year of age.
