#### LIVERPOOL, Governor-General.

WHEREAS by the three hundred and twenty first section of the Land Act, 1908, it is enacted that the Governor-General may from time to time, either by general or particular description, and whether the same has been surveyed or not, reserve from sale temporarily, notwithstanding that the same may be then held under pastoral license, any Crown lands which in his opinion are required for any of the purposes in the said section mentioned:

And whereas by the sixty-ninth section of the Land for Settlements Act, 1908, it is further provided that the Governor-General may from time to time, as he thinks fit, set aside reserves for any specified public purpose out of land acquired under the last-mentioned Act, provided that no land so acquired shall be set aside for endowments:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Acts, do hereby temporarily reserve from sale the lands in the Hawke's Bay Land District described in the Schedule hereunder written, for the purposes in the said Schedule specified at the end of the respective descriptions of the lands so intended to be temporarily reserved.

##### HAWKE'S BAY LAND DISTRICT.

ALL that area in the Hawke's Bay Land District, containing by admeasurement 2 roods, more or less, being Section 76, Town of Havelock North. *Special Shooting Season for Imported and Native Game, License Fee, &c., Mangonui-Whangaroa Acclimatization District.*

#### LIVERPOOL, Governor-General.

IN exercise of the powers vested in me by the Animals Protection Act, 1908, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby exempt from the operation of section twenty-six of the said Act the Mangonui-Whangaroa Acclimatization District, and do hereby notify that the following imported game—viz., cock pheasants and Australian quail—may be killed within the Mangonui-Whangaroa Acclimatization District, comprising the Counties of Mangonui and Whangaroa (except in the areas mentioned in the Schedule hereto), from the first day of May, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, to the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, both days inclusive; and do hereby restrict the number of cock pheasants that may be killed by any one person in any one day to twelve.
