*Defining River and Extended-river Limits for Bay of Islands.*

IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred upon me by section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, Thomas Mason Wilford, Minister of Marine, do hereby define the Bay of Islands river and extended-river limits within which restricted-limit steamships and ships propelled by gas, oil, fluid, electricity, or any mechanical power other than steam, and to which restricted-limit certificates are issued, may ply to be those set forth herein.

*River Limits.*—Inside a line starting from the north-easternmost point of the eastern entrance to Rangihoua Bay, from

there going to the north-easternmost point of the easternmost of the Black Rocks, thence by a straight line to the northernmost point of Motu Arohia Island, thence by a straight line to the north-western point of Motu Rua Island, thence by a straight line to the north-western point of Motukiekie Island, thence by a straight line to the south-western point of Oruapukapuka Island, thence following the western and southern coast of that island to the point of the island immediately opposite Long Island, thence by a straight line to the south-western point of Richards Peninsula; as the same is shown by red lines on the chart marked M.D. 5043, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington.

*Extended-river Limits.*—Inside a straight line drawn from Cape Wiwiki to Cape Brett.

All previous limits for the Bay of Islands are hereby revoked.
