IN pursuance and exercise of the power and authority conferred on him by the Public Health Act, 1908, as amended by the Public Health Amendment Act, 1918, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations for the purposes of the said Acts.

## REGULATIONS.

1. EACH member of the Board of Public Health, not being an officer of the Public Service, shall be paid the sum of one guinea for every day on which he attends a meeting of the Board, together with the sum of 10s. 6d. for every night during which he is necessarily absent from his home by

reason of such attendance. 2. In all claims by any such members for payment of the travelling-expenses reasonably incurred by him in attending meetings of the Board and in transacting the business thereof, full particulars shall be shown for the purposes of audit, and, except in the case of train fares, ordinary steamer fares, and ordinary coach fares, receipts for all payments made in excess of 5s. shall accompany the claim.
