A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto is required to be taken, under the Public Works Act, 1908, for a certain public work—to wit, for the purposes of a public school in the City of Wellington:

And whereas an agreement has been entered into between the Education Board of the District of Wellington and the owners of the land described in the Schedule hereto, to take such land for the public work hereinafter set forth:

And whereas the Education Board of the District of Wellington has laid before the Governor-General a memorial, accompanied by a map in duplicate, as required by the Public Works Act, 1908:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and the Education Act, 1914, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, and being satisfied of the sufficiency of the agreement hereinbefore referred to, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a public school, and shall vest in the Education Board of the District of Wellington, on and after the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect as from the first day of February, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
