The following are the regulations referred to:-

GERALDINE RACING CLUB.

REGULATIONS.

(Under the Gaming Act, 1908.)

In pursuance and exercise of the powers in that behalf contained in section 33 of the Gaming Act, 1908, and of all other powers and authorities it enabling in that behalf, the Geraldine Racing Club, a racing club within the meaning of the said Act (hereinafter referred to as "the said club"), doth hereby revoke the regulations dated the 20th day of September, 1906, also the regulations made 29th May, 1912, and in lieu thereof doth hereby make the following regulations controlling the admission of persons to that part of the racecontrolling the admission of persons to that part of the race-course situated in the district of Orari, and known as the Geraldine Racecourse, while the said racecourse is used or occupied by the said club for race meetings.

(c.) All persons under disqualification inflicted by any (c.) All persons under disqualineation innicted by any racing or trotting club in the Dominion of New Zealand, the Commonwealth of Australia, or elsewhere, if affiliated to the New Zealand Racing Conference, or the New Zealand Trotting Association, or the New Zealand Trotting Conference.

(d.) Common prostitutes and persons who habitually content with this year of persons who habitually content with this year of persons who have the level.

visible means of support.

(e.) Professional tipsters, persons convicted of house-breaking or pocket-picking, forgery, uttering or possessing counterfeit coin, theft, false pretences, receiving stolen goods, mischief, assault, or any offence or crime of any kind under the Crimes Act, 1908, and also idle and disorderly persons, rogues 475 and vagabonds, and incorrigible rogues convicted under the Police Offences Act, 1908, and persons convicted of an offence under the Gaming Act, 1908.
