RESOLUTION MAKING AND LEVYING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Whangamomona County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also the other charges on a loan of one hundred and fifty pounds (£150), authorized to be raised by the Whangamomona County Council, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for re-formation and metalling the Putikituna Road, the said Whangamomona County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of five-sixteenths of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Putikituna Road Special Rating Area, comprising Sections 15, 16, 17, Block XV, and Section 4, Block XIV, Pouatu Survey District; Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, Block III, and Sections 8 and 9, Block II, Mahoe Survey District. And that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable half-yearly on the first day of January and the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and a half years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
