CIRCULAR TO OWNERS AND MASTERS OF BRITISH MERCHANT SHIPS.

WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY IN MERCHANT SHIPS .- RELAXATION of Restrictions.

I. Disposal of Documents.

Two copies of this circular are to be supplied to every British merchant ship fitted with W/T.

2. One copy is to be kept in the W/T office, the other by the master.

3. This circular is to come into force at noon, G.M.T., on Thursday, 1st May, 1919, when the following action is to be taken on board merchant ships, if this has not already been

(a.) Circulars to owners and masters of British merchant ships dated 22nd January and 12th March, 1919, are to be destroyed.

(b.) Para. 3 of circular letter to shipowners and masters of the British mercantile marine, dated 23rd Novem-

ber, 1918, issued by the Director of Trade Division,
Admiralty, already deleted, is to be marked "See
circular of 10th April, 1919."

(c.) The following documents are to be handed to the
nearest Shipping Intelligence Officer or other distributing authority for destruction,—

Vessels, 1918. Addendum No. 3 (1 copy).

Mercantile Tables (all editions up to and including
No. 35).

(d.) The following documents are to be withdrawn from use and kept on board, but need no longer be regarded as confidential. They will be replaced later by revised instructions.
