

*The Arms Act, 1920.—Appointment of Authorized Officers.*

*The Arms Act, 1920.—Purchase and Sale of Pea-rifle Ammunition.*

PURSUANT to clause 18 of the regulations made on 22nd November, 1920, under the Arms Act, 1920, I, John O'Donovan, the Commissioner of Police, do hereby authorize that ammunition for small sporting-rifles not exceeding 0.22 in. calibre may be purchased and sold without a permit in any part of the Dominion until such time as this authority shall be revoked by me by notification to that effect in the *New Zealand Gazette*.
