LIVERPOOL, Governor-General. [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION.

Mumb. 11.

TN exercise and pursuance of the powers and authorities I vested in me by the River Boards Act, 1908, as amended by the River Boards Amendment Act, 1910, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that, from and after the date hereof, that part of the said Dominion described in the First Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby constituted a district under the said be and and shall be known by the name of the Mangawara River District; and that the said district shall be subdivided into five subdivisions, to be called the First Subdivision, the Second Subdivision, the Third Subdivision, the Fourth Subdivision, Subdivision, the Third Subdivision, the Fourth Subdivision, and the Fifth Subdivision, the boundaries whereof shall be those described in the Second Schedule hereto; that the number of members who are to constitute the Board of the said district shall be nine; and that two members shall be elected for the First Subdivision, two members for the Second Subdivision, one member for the Third Subdivision, two members for the Fourth Subdivision, and two members for the Fifth Subdivision. And L do also proclaim and declare that Norman Gillard

And I do also proclaim and declare that Norman Gillard Gribble, of Hamilton, shall be the Returning Officer to conduct the first elections of each subdivision of the aforesaid conduct the first elections of each subdivision of the atoresaid district; that Saturday, the twenty-first day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, shall be the day, and the Taupiri Hall, Taupiri, the Orini Hall, Orini, and the Tau-hei School, Tauhei, shall be the places, for holding such first elections; and that Thursday, the twenty-sixth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, at ten club the prime shall be the time and twenty at ten February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty, at ten o'clock in the morning, shall be the time, and the office of Mr. N. G. Gribble, Victoria Street, Hamilton, shall be the place, at which the first meeting of the members of the Board of the said river district shall be held. And, lastly, I do proclaim and declare that Thomas Baker Insoll, of Hamilton, shall be the person to make a roll of elec-tors for the purposes of the aforesaid first elections in the manner prescribed by section eight of the said River Boards Act. 1908.

FIRST SCHEDULE. MANGAWARA RIVER DISTRICT.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the common boundary of Sections 445 and 456, Taupiri Parish, with the Waikato River; thence proceeding along the north-western boundary of said Section 456, along the western and northern boundaries aries of Sections 481 and 455, Taupiri Parish (crossing a road); thence along the north-western boundaries generally of Sections 469, 470, 471, 450A, 450B, 450C, and 451, Taupiri Parish, to the northernmost corner of the last named; thence due north to the hornermost conter of the last hand; thence due north to the boundary between Blocks IX and XIII, Hapuakohe Survey District; thence due west along that block-line to the boundary between the Rangiriri and Hapua-kohe Survey Districts; thence due north along that boundary kohe Survey Districts; thence due north along that boundary to its intersection with a right line from the northernmost corner of Section 196, Taupiri Parish, through Pukemore Trig. Station No. 676a; thence along that right line and along the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 196, 194, and 193, Taupiri Parish; thence along the road forming the castern boundary of the last-named section; thence along the road forming the northern boundary of Part Section 465 to its terminus on the south boundary of Section 177, Parish of Taupiri; thence along a right line to the southernmost corner of Section 208, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the south-eastern boundary of said Section 208 (across a road) and along the south-eastern boundary of Section 307, Parish of Taupiri; thence across that road and along the eastern side to the road forming the southern boundary of Section 307, Parish of Taupiri; thence across that road and along the eastern side of the road forming the western boundaries of said Section 307 and road forming the western boundaries of said Section 307 and Sections 489, 232, 231, 230, 229, and 512, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the northern boundary of said Section 512 and thence along the northern boundary of said Section 512 and Section 490, across a road, and along the road forming the western boundaries of Sections 404, 399, 398, 402, and 403, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the north-western boundary of the last named; thence along the road forming the north-eastern boundaries generally of said Section 403 and Sec-tions 402, 398, 399, 404, 406, 444, and 347, Parish of Taupiri, and continuing along that road through Section 474c to its southern boundaries of Sections 440 and 474B, Parish of northern boundaries of Sections 440 and 474B, Parish of

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Taupiri, and the south-eastern boundary of the last named to the Tahuna Road; thence easterly along that road to the western boundary of Hoe-o-Tainui North 5A 2E Block; thence along the western and northern boundaries of that block, the western boundaries of $6B \ 2E \ 2$, the western, northern, and north-eastern boundaries of $6B \ 2E \ 2$, the north-eastern boundary of $6B \ 2F$, and part of the north-eastern boundary of $6B \ 2B \ to$ and across the Tahuna Road; thence easterly 6B 2B to and across the Tahuna Koad; thence easterly along that road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 6 (on L.T. plan 8697); thence across that road and along said eastern boundary and the eastern and northern boundary of Lot 7; thence along the road forming the western boundaries of Lots 8 and 9 (on L.T. plan 8697) and along the northern boundary of the last named, the northern boundary of Lot 4, the eastern boundaries of Lots 10 and 11 (of the 2T sales 2607) the southern brandwise of South 10 and 11 (all on L.T. plan 8697), the southern boundaries of Lots 10 and 11 (all on L.T. plan 8697), the southern boundaries of Section 2, Block VIII, Hapuakohe Survey District, and Section 13, Block V, Waitoa Survey District, to Te Ranga Trig. Station; thence along the western boundaries of Sections 1a and 1B, Hoe-o-Tainui North Block, and Sections 1 and 2, Block IX, Waitoa Survey District; thence casterly along the northern boundary of Hoe-o-Tainui South No. 4 Block; thence along the eastern boundary of that block, the north-eastern boundary of Crown land in Block IX, Waitoa Survey District, the northeastern and north-western boundaries of Hoe-o-Tainui South 48 1s Block, and the south-western boundaries of Hoe-o-rainul South rainul South No. 4 Block to the confiscation line; thence south along that line (being the western boundaries of Hoe-o-Tainul South No. 1 and Hangawera Blocks) to the Tauhei-Morrinsville Road; thence easterly along that road to a point in line with the boundary between Lots 3 and 4, Hanga-ware Block , thence along the could weet me houndary of wera Block; thence along the south-western boundary of said Lot 3 to drain reserve; thence along that drain reserve to the north-eastern corner of Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 3458A); to the north-eastern corner of Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 3458A); thence along the eastern boundary of the last-named lot to and across a road; thence westerly along that road to the north-western corner of Lot 10 (L.T. plan 3458A); thence southerly along the road forming the south-western bound-aries of said Lot 10, Lot 9 (on the said plan), and part Motu-maoho No. 1 to a point in line with the southern boundary of Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 4952A); thence along the south-eastern boundary of said Lot 1 to the confiscation line; thence north along said confiscation line to the north, western eastern boundary of said Lot 1 to the confiscation line; thence north along said confiscation line to the north-western boundary of Lot 10 (on L.T. plan 5548A); thence along the said boundary of Lot 10 and along the northern boundaries of Lots 5, 4, 3, and 2 (on L.T. plan 5548A); thence by the northern boundaries of Lots 5, 4, 3, 2, 6, and 1 (on L.T. plan 6454A); thence along the south-western boundary of part Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 7344), across Tauhei Road, and along the south-western boundaries generally of Lot 9 (on L.T. plan 5402A), Lots 2 and 1 (on L.T. plan 7795), part Lot 2 (on L.T. plan 7768), and Lots 2 and 1 (on L.T. plan 6632): (on L.T. plan 7768), and Lots 2 and 1 (on L.T. plan 6632); thence along the northern boundary of Lot East 5 (on L.T. Plan 5021A), the south-eastern boundary of Section 174, Parish of Taupiri, and the south-eastern and north-eastern boundaries of Section 171, Parish of Taupiri, to the Taupiri-Orini Road; thence along the north-western boundaries of said Section 171 to and across the road intersecting Sec-tion 172, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the south-eastern side of that road through Sections 173, 175, 335, and 449, Parish of Taupiri, and continuing along that road to the left bank of Wangamire Stream, thence down that stream to the left bank of the Mangawara Stream, thence down that stream to the Waikato River, thence down the Waikato River to the place of commencement.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

FIRST SUBDIVISION.

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the common boundary of Sections 445 and 456, Taupiri Parish, with the Waikato River; thence proceeding north-easterly generally along the boundary of the Mangawara River District as described in the First Schedule hereto to the north-east corner of Section 440, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the north-eastern boundaries of that section and Sections 442 and 443, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 443 and 435, Parish of Taupiri, to the Mangawara Stream; thence down that stream to the north-western corner of Section 157A, Parish of Taupiri; thence down the road forming the north-eastern boundaries of Sections 167

and 166, and the north-eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Section 165, and intersecting Section 164, all in Parish of Taupiri; thence along the Taupiri-Orini Road to the boundary of the Mangawara River District as described in the First Schedule hereto; thence in a south-westerly direction generally along the said Mangawara River District boundary to the point of commencement.

SECOND SUBDIVISION.

All that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the confluence of the Mangawara and Tauhei Streams; thence proceeding up the said Mangawara Stream to the south-eastern boundary of Section 435, Parish of Taupiri; thence south-westerly along the said boundary; thence along the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of Section 478, Parish of Taupiri; thence along the northeastern and south-eastern boundaries of the land shown on L.T. plan 4263A; thence along the northern boundaries generally of Lot 5 (on L.T. plan 4719A) to a public road; thence north-westerly along that road to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 6, Rewi Settlement; thence to and along that boundary to Tauhei Stream; thence down said stream to the point of commencement.

THIRD SUBDIVISION.

All that area in the Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at the north-eastern corner of Section 440, Parish of Taupiri; thence proceeding easterly, southerly, and westerly generally along the boundary of the Mangawara River District as described in the First Schedule hereto to the south-east corner of the land shown on L.T. plan 7615; thence along the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of that land and the western boundary of Section 478a, Parish of Taupiri, and the south-western and western boundaries generally of Section 474b to the place of commencement.

FOURTH SUBDIVISION.

All that area in the Auckland Land District commencing at the north-eastern corner of Section 171, Parish of Taupiri; thence north-easterly generally along the southern boundaries of Subdivisions 1 and 2 (Mangawara River District) hereinbefore described to the north-east corner of Section 2, Rewi Settlement; thence along the north-eastern boundary of that section and the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 7, 8, 9, and 10, Rewi Settlement, Lot 11 (on L.T. plan 6230A), and Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 6566); thence south-westerly and northwesterly generally along the boundary of the Mangawara River District as described in the First Schedule hereto to the point of commencement.

FIFTH SUBDIVISION.

All that area in the Auckland Land District commencing at the south-west corner of Lot 1 (on L.T. plan 6566); thence north-westerly along the boundary of Subdivision 4 (Mangawara River District) hereinbefore described to the Tauhei Stream; thence in an easterly direction generally along the southern boundaries of Subdivisions 2 and 3 (Mangawara River District) hereinbefore described to the south-east corner of land shown on L.T. plan 7616; thence southeasterly and westerly generally along the boundary of the Mangawara River District as described in the First Schedule hereto to the point of commencement.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Right Honourable Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, Member of His Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Member of the Royal Victorian Order, Knight of Justice of the Order of Saint John of Jerusalem, Governor-General and Commanderin-Chief in and over His Majesty's Dominion of New Zealand and its Dependencies; and issued under the Seal of the said Dominion, at the Government House at Wellington, this twenty-ninth day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty.
