**A PROCLAMATION.**

**W**HEREAS the land mentioned in the Schedule hereto is Crown land, and is required to be set apart for the purposes of the Hurunui-Waitaki Railway in Block X, Christchurch Survey District:

And whereas by section twenty-one of the Public Works Act, 1908, it is enacted that whenever any Crown land is required to be set apart for any public work the Governor-General may at any time, by Proclamation, set the same apart for such public work without complying with any of the provisions of that Act in respect to the taking or setting-apart of other lands for such purpose:

Now, therefore, I, Arthur William de Brito Savile, Earl of Liverpool, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in that behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for the purposes of the said railway; and I also hereby declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-eighth day of February, one thousand nine hundred and twenty.
