*Resignation of Member of House of Representatives for Electoral District of Bruce.*

WHEREAS the House of Representatives is not now in session, and there is no Speaker of the said House :  
Now, therefore, pursuant to the provisions of the Legislature Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General directs it to be notified that the Honourable Sir James Allen, K.C.B., has, by writing under his hand addressed to the Governor-General, resigned his seat in the House of Representatives for the Electoral District of Bruce ; that such resignation was received on the 22nd day of March, 1920 ; and that the seat is vacant by reason thereof.
