Fatal Accident, Brighton Coal-mine, Dunedin .- Notice of Suspension of Mine-manager's Certificate.

HEREAS a Court at Dunedin held an inquiry on the 6th day of February, 1920, before Mr. H. Y. Widdow-son, Stipendiary Magistrate, and James Carruthers and William Braidwood, Assessors, into the accident at the Brighton Coal-mine on the 26th day of August, 1919, result-ing in the death of Robert William Smith: Now, therefore, after hearing the evidence of witnesses, notice of the following judgment is given by the Stipendiary Magistrate to the Minister of Mines in terms of section 7 of the Coal-mines Amendment Act, 1914: "I hereby give you notice that upon an application in that behalf made by the Inspector of Mines, and dated the 2nd day of January, 1920, a Court duly constituted under the provisions of section 7 of the Coal-mines Amendment Act, 1914, this day held an inquiry under the said section into the

1914, this day held an inquiry under the said section into the matter of an accident in the Brighton Coal-mine on the

26th day of August, 1919, resulting in the death of one Robert William Smith. And the said Court found that the said accident was caused by the non-observance by David McNeill, the holder of a second-class mine-manager's certificate, of Special Rule No. 21 in the Second Schedule of the Coal-mines Act, 1908, and by his negligence, and in the circumstances the Court disqualified the said David McNeill by suspending bis said certificate for a puriod of seven deug as from the his said certificate for a period of seven days as from the

date hereof. "Dated at Dunedin this 6th day of February, 1920.
