IMPROVEMENTS.

The improvements included in the capital values of the sections consist of boundary and subdivisional fences valued as follows: Section 1s, £92 12s.; Section 2s, £84 14s.; Section 3s, £63 12s.; Section 4s, £87 19s.; Section 5s, £147; Section 6s, £69 5s.; Section 7s, £41 10s.
