That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £6,500, authorized to be raised by the Oxford County Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for one-third share in estimated cost of public hospital, erection of bridge over Cooper's Creek, erection of clerk's house, water-race, caretaker's house, and Council Chambers, the said Oxford County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eighth of a penny (gd.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable properties in the County of Oxford; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and shall be payable yearly in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
