And whereas it is found that the additional land in Blocks V and II, Toetoes Survey District, taken for the Catlins-Seaward Bush Railway (Tokanui Section) by a Proclamation made under the Public Works Act, 1908, dated the twenty-eighth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen (hereinafter termed "the said Proclamation"), and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 162, pages 3870/1, of the fifth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and eighteen, is not now required for the purpose for which it was taken:
