## CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL.

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATES.

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

(1.) That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of seven thousand five hundred pounds (£7,500), authorized to be raised by the Christchurch City Council, under the above-mentioned Act, for paying off the

balance of the Linwood Public Works Loan of £10,500, the Christchurch City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of forty-four one-hundred-and-twenty-sevenths ( $\frac{44}{127}$ ) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (being the unimproved value) of all rateable property comprised in the former Borough of Linwood; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six (36) years, or until the loan is fully paid off.
