Result of Poll on Proposal to raise a Loan.

PURSUANT to section 12 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, I hereby give notice that a poll of the ratepayers of the Borough of Balclutha was taken on the 16th day of June, 1920, on the proposal of the Balclutha Borough Council to borrow the sum of £1,000 for the purpose of widening and strengthening the river-protection embankment.

The number of votes recorded for the proposal was 66, and the number of votes recorded against the proposal was 1. I therefore declare that the proposal was carried.
