Settlement Land set apart for Disposal by way of Sale or Lease to Discharged Soldiers, under Special Tenures, in the Taranaki

A PROCLAMATION.

I N pursuance of the power and authority conferred upon me by section four of the Discharged Soldiers Settlement Act, 1915, I, Robert Stout, the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the area of settlement land described in the Schedule hereto shall be and the same is hereby set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or set apart and declared open for disposal by way of sale or lease to discharged soldiers, under special tenures, in the manner provided in the said Act.

SCHEDULE.

TARANAKI LAND DISTRICT .- SETTLEMENT LAND. Mangamaire Settlement .-- Ngatimaru Survey District.

FIRSTLY, all that piece or parcel of land, containing by admeasurement 300 acres, being Sections 22 and 23 of Block II, Ngatimaru Survey District, being bounded as follows: On the north by Section 16 of the same block and district, 1296:4 and 2395 links; on the east by Section 25 of same block and district, 8823 links; on the south and west generally by the Junction Road and Matau Road, 3183:4 and 9118.4 links.
