IN pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1911, and of all other powers in anywise enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth, subject to the conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto and to the regulations made under section two of the aforesaid Act, dated the twenty-second day of September, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and published in the New Zealand Gazette of the twenty-fifth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, or any regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor, and hereinafter collectively referred to as "the regulations," and which regulations shall be deemed to be incorporated herein, hereby authorize Callile George Bouzaid,
