IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Amendment Act, 1909, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, I, Robert Stout, the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke part of the Proclamation dated the sixteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the twenty-fourth day of the same month, taking land for a further portion of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway, Napier Northwards (part Eskdale and Tutira Sections), and for road approaches thereto, in so far as such Proclamation affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, such land being not now required for the purpose for which it was taken.
