**ELSTOW DRAINAGE BOARD.**

**RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL INTEREST RATES.**

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Elstow Drainage Board hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the instalments in respect of principal and interest and also other charges on a loan of £500, being ten per centum of the original loan of £5,000 authorized to be raised by the Elstow Drainage Board, under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, for the purpose of completing drainage-works within the Elstow No. 2 Special Rating Area of the Elstow Drainage District, the said Elstow Drainage Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eighth of one penny in the pound on the unimproved value of all lands in Class A, one-sixteenth of one penny in the pound on the unimproved value of all lands in Class B, and one thirty-second of one penny in the pound on the unimproved value of all lands in Class C, all of which classes and the lands therein, as set out on the classification list and valuation schedule of the Elstow No. 2 Special Rating Area, the boundaries of which are as follows,—
