Amendments and Additions to the Regulations under the Public Service Act, 1912.

I N pursuance and exercise of the authority conferred on him by the Public Service Act, 1912 (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the Commissioner, with the approval of the Administrator of the Government in Council, doth hereby, in respect of the regulations made under the said Act on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and published in the New Zealand Gazette on the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, and the amendments thereof made from time to time under the provisions of the said Act, make the amendments shown in the Schedule hereto.

Such amendments shall have effect from and after the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty.

SCHEDULE.

REGULATION 8E is hereby revoked, and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

RATE OF PAYMENT.

8E. The following shall be the rate of payment for overtime, where such payment is sanctioned, and shall apply only to officers of the Professional and Clerical Divisions:—

Officers receiving a salary of £215 per annum and s. d under 1 6

Officers receiving over £215 and not exceeding £250 per annum ... 1 9

Officers receiving over £250 and not exceeding £280 per annum 20

Officers receiving over £280 and not exceeding £400 per annum ... 26

Overtime shall be calculated to the nearest quarter of an hour. Officers of the General Division whose cases are not met by special regulation in that behalf may be paid for overtime at such rate as may be fixed by the Commissioner from time to time.

Regulation No. 201 is hereby amended by striking out the figures " $\pounds 300$," and substituting therefor the figures " $\pounds 350$."

Regulation No. 213 is hereby revoked, and the following substituted therefor :---
