**A PROCLAMATION.**

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1908, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, John Rushworth, Viscount Jellicoe, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of a public school, and shall vest in the Education Board of the District of Hawke's Bay, as from the date herein after mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the sixteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and twenty.
