In exercise of the powers in me vested by section 40 of the Judicature Act, 1908, I, Sir Robert Stout, K.C.M.G., Chief Justice of New Zealand, hereby fix and declare the sums specified in the Schedule hereto to be the fees and poundage to be paid and taken by any Sheriff, Deputy Sheriff, Sheriff's Officer, Bailiff, or other person employed under any Sheriff or Deputy Sheriff, upon any proceedings in the Supreme Court in its civil or criminal jurisdiction, or otherwise in respect of the office or employment of any such officers as aforesaid, such fees and poundage to be paid and taken as aforesaid to be in lieu of the table of fees under the Sheriffs Act, 1883, published in the New Zealand Gazette on the 25th day of May, 1893.
