RESOLUTION LEVYING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by subsection (d) of section sixteen of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, the Counties Act, 1908, and of section thirty-three of the Counties Amendment Act, 1913, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Taranaki County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Taranaki County Council Workers' Dwellings Loan of £2,000, 1920, authorized to be raised by the Council, under the abovementioned Acts, for the purpose of erecting workers' dwellings within the said county, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one twenty-fourth (1/24th) of a penny in the pound sterling on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Taranaki; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-six and one-half (36½) years, or until the loan is fully paid off. 958
