##### RESOLUTION STRIKING SPECIAL RATE.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and amendments thereto, the Raglan County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £10,000, authorized to be raised by the Raglan County Council, under the provisions of the Counties Act, 1908, the Counties Amendment Act, 1913, the Housing Act, 1919, the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1913, and amendments thereto, and all other Acts (if any) it in that behalf enabling, and with the consent of the Governor-General in Council under section 20 of the Finance Act, 1919, as gazetted on page 2481 of the *New Zealand Gazette*, 1920, for the purpose of erecting workers' dwellings within the County of Raglan, the Raglan County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eleventh of a penny in the pound sterling upon the rateable value of all rateable property within the County of Raglan; and it is the intention to pay out of the loan the first year's interest and sinking fund.
